The Crossing the Blues: La Grande Summer Festival is seeking art and craft vendors for the third annual celebration of art, music, film, theater and literature.

In 2009, an estimated 500 people attended the event. By applying expanded marketing efforts, we expect to double the attendance for the 2010 festival.

Some events slated for the festival are as follows:

- Street dance with live music, both Friday and Saturday evenings
- Art walk
- Writing marathon and open mic
- Outdoor Theater
- Live music – all day, Aug. 21
- Beer garden, both Friday and Saturday
- Sprint Triathlon
- Artists quick draw competition
- Chalk art exhibition and workshop
- Farmers' market
- Food and Art vendors

VENDOR CONTRACT

This contract, by and between _____ (participant's name) hereinafter called the Vendor and the Crossing the Blues Summer: La Grande Summer Festival Organizing Committee, hereinafter called the CTB, on this _____ day of _____, 2010, hereby mutually agree as follows:

1. **SPACE:** CTB shall sublet and assign to the Vendor a 10'x10' space at the Crossing the Blues: La Grande Summer Festival on 21st of August in La Grande, OR.
2. **FEES:**
Early-bird Special! Vendor fee is \$10 when you reserve your space by July 1!
Reservations made between July 2 and July 31: \$15.
Reservations made between Aug. 1 and Aug. 20: \$20.
Tables and chairs are available for rent at Eastern Oregon Rentals in La Grande.
3. If for some reason you have to cancel your reservation you **MUST** notify our office by Aug. 7, 2010 to receive a 50% (fifty percent) refund. No refund will be granted after this date.
4. **LIABILITY:** The Vendor hereby assumes all risks and hazards incidental to such sales and exhibits. Vendor further agrees to hold harmless CTB, City of La Grande, La Grande Downtown Development Association, Union County Chamber of Commerce and Union County from any claims arising out of such sales and exhibits, whether the result of negligence or any other cause.
5. **TERMS AND CONDITIONS:** This contract contains all the terms and conditions agreed on by the parties hereto; and no other agreement, oral or otherwise, regarding the subject matter of this contract, shall be deemed to exist or bind any of the parties hereto.
6. **CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE:** Vendors are **not** required to present a certificate of insurance to participate in CTB. However, it is recommended that you purchase insurance to protect yourself and your property public liability for any damage to, or destruction of property and for all other claims arising out of a single accident or occurrence.
7. **NO AGENCY/PARTNERSHIP:** The parties understand and agree that Vendor is an independent contractor and is not an employee or partner with the CTB, the City of La Grande, the Union County Chamber of Commerce, the La Grande Main Street, or Union County. The parties understand and agree that the act of each party hereto is the individual act of the party and neither party shall be deemed to be the employee, agent, representative or partner of the other.
8. **LICENSES:** Obtaining all licenses (city, county, state or federal) or permits required by law of an Vendor in the installation or operation of his/her booth shall be the sole responsibility of the Vendor at his/her own expense prior to the opening of the Festival.
9. **EXHIBIT HOURS:** All Vendors agree to the following hours: Booths or exhibits cannot be dismantled or removed until after closing time. Those not in compliance with the established hours may forfeit their right to participate in

future festivals. Vendors agree to staff their booths for the full day of the festival from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., August 21, 2010.

10. EQUIPMENT: Vendors will provide all equipment needed, such as tents, easels, power, tables and chairs. etc.

SET-UP HOURS:

You may begin setting up at 8:00 a.m., Saturday morning (please allow enough time to set up before the vendor area opens up for the public at 9:00 a.m.

RESTRICTIONS AND RIGHTS OF ASSOCIATION:

CTB reserves the right to restrict or to remove booths/exhibits without refund if they have been falsely entered or deemed by the CTB as unsuitable or objectionable. This restriction applies, but is not limited to: noise, PA systems, persons, animals and other things, conduct, printed matter, or anything of the character that might be objectionable to the City of La Grande or CTB. CTB and City of La Grande shall not be liable for any damages or other expenses that Vendor in the event that the festival is delayed, interrupted, or not held as scheduled for any reason whatsoever. If, for any reason beyond the control of the organizer, the festival is not held, the organizing committee will refund vendor fees.
